Dear Parents and Guardians:

In accordance with the *No Child Left Behind Act of 2001* (NCLB), Section 1111(h)(6) PARENTS' RIGHT-TO-KNOW, this is a notification from Covington Douglas District to every parent of a student in a Title I school that you have the right to request and receive information in a timely manner regarding the professional qualifications of your student's classroom teachers.
